

Questions from Vendors

1. Q. Community Resource Project Inc has been a successful partner under an existing cooperative purchasing contract. If awarded a vendor relationship for the subject effort is it acceptable to perform in accordance with the proposal and the current cooperative purchasing contract – including the associated rebate?
A. Yes
2. Q. We emphasize our everyday low price as an asset to our customers and we plan on including pricing for an estimated one month worth of products needed by Community Resource Project Inc. We can update pricing every 30 days for the products on the list, as the prices are subject to change due to market conditions; is this acceptable to Community Resource Project Inc in lieu of annual fixed prices?
A. Please state this in your response to the request for quotation.
3. Q. We require a form of payment at the time of each transaction. Does Community Resource Project Inc plan on using credit cards or would they prefer we sign them up to a Net 30 Commercial Account?
A. We will discuss specific credit requirements upon award of contract
4. Q. We, as a vendor, pass through to Community Resource Project Inc the product manufacturer's warranty, many of which are warranted for one year or longer, some are not. Is it acceptable to clarify that product warranties are based on what the manufacturer provides?
A. Yes
5. Q. Delivery is available and we intend to cite any delivery charges separately – not embedded in product prices. In some cases there will be little or no delivery charges – is this distinction acceptable to Community Resource Project Inc?
A. Yes. We would appreciate specific amounts for known delivery charges. Estimates are acceptable.
6. Q. Are all materials supplied under this contract to be manufactured and/or assembled in the USA?
A. It is preferred but not required. Items manufactured and/or assemble in the USA are to be given preference in the procurement process.
7. Q. Will doors require any hinge or door lock prep?
A. No
8. Q. Regarding 3.5" and 4" hinges: Are these solid brass or US3 finish? What is the Radius on corners? Can you specify any manufacturer's model that meets your current standards?
A. The hinges currently used are US3 brass ¼ radius manufactured by Huntington Hardware.

9. Q. Please clarify standard for ½” exterior plywood.
A. The plywood is a CDX 5-ply fir
10. Q. What is your preferred size (width) and facing for R30 insulation?
A. 16”
11. Q. Please clarify standards and quantities for the line item Screws
What manufacturer's model meets your standard for Corner Pad?
What is the specific size required for Foam Tape (closed cell)?
A. Please disregard these categories.
11. Q. Please clarify specifications for Gas Water Heaters. It appears that specifications for Electric Water Heaters are listed in the standards column for gas units.
A. You are correct; the specs for the Electric Water Heaters were incorrectly inserted in the Gas Water Heater section. Gas Water Heaters must meet California Title 24 requirements.
12. Q. Please specify what California Title 24 regulations single and double wall furnaces must meet. Please review and clarify standards for single and double wall furnaces (5 yr warranty on tank?)
A. Wall furnaces must meet CFR 1 and 4 requirements under Title 24.
